Q : GAIG/USDF - Great American Insurance Group/USDF Qualifying class for 2011 show year, state qualifying on entry form and add \$10 to fee.

Freestyle TOC: State level on entry. Freestyle entrants must also submit photocopy of 60%+ ride in highest test of level, or higher.

***Test of Choice :** Any USEF, USDF, or FEI test not offered in class list above. May be qualifying classes only if correct test is ridden.

Opportunity*** classes are exempt from all horse ID and membership requirements and the \$15.00 USEF Fee.

AQHA APPROVED: Heads up Quarter Horses!! Scores of 60% + at Training Level 4 and higher can earn AQHA points for your horse at this show. To be eligible, horse and rider must meet all AQHA and USDF www.USDF.org membership requirements and the horse must be AQHA registered, have current AQHA papers, and have an AQHA Lifetime Dressage Competition License (nomination form available at: http://www.aqha.com/forms/pdf/AQHA_Dressage_Nomination.pdf). Refunds:

Full refund if scratch is received by closing date less \$20 office fee.

No refunds after closing date or after start of competition -This includes classes canceled due to severe weather or other emergency conditions.

Bounced Check Policy:

\$30 fee; Entry wait-listed until cashier's check received.

Post Entries:

Will be placed on a waiting list to fill scratches. All "No Shows" that have not contacted the show office prior to first ride will be considered a scratch for the show and time slots may be filled.

Guest Horses:

Must send in a completed entry form with a \$35 guest horse fee plus the \$20 office fee, submit a current coggins, and pay either stabling or day parking.

Music for Freestyles:

Must be on cassette tapes or CDs provided by the competitor to announcer at least two hours prior to the start of the freestyle class.

Stabling:

490 Permanent stalls with Permanent doors, half in center-aisled stand.

2 Bags of shavings are included with horse stall (Excludes Tack). PLEASE PRE-ORDER EXTRA BEDDING PRIOR TO ARRIVAL. The price of extra bedding is: \$8.00 per bag (preordered) and \$10.00 per bag on the grounds.

Groups of 6 or more will receive a FREE tack stall.

Directions:

WNC Horse Complex, 1301 Fanning Bridge rd, Fletcher, NC 28732

From I-40 take I-26 towards Hendersonville. Take exit#40 (Airport rd). Go West towards the Airport. The WNC Horse Complex is directly across from the Airport.

Arenas:

Two 20x60 sand competition arenas: one indoor with spectator seating and one outdoor. Covered warm-up arena. No one on foot is allowed in the warm-up area—coaching must be done from the side. All arenas will be open for schooling on Thursday and Friday until 8pm. Saturday, schooling in the arenas will be allowed after the last ride and until 8 pm.

Hospitality:

Food available on the grounds during breakfast and lunch hours.

Competitor/Volunteer Party:

In the coliseum after the last of the day

HEADGEAR: Effective March 1, 2011, for open dressage: Anyone mounted on a horse must wear protective headgear except those riders age 18 and over while on horses that are competing only in FEI levels and tests at the Prix St. Georges level and above (including FEI Young Rider Tests, the USEF Developing Prix St. Georges Test and the USEF Brentina Cup Test).

ENTRY DOCUMENTATION REQUIREMENTS

- Current USEF membership (or n/m fees) for Rider, Owner and Trainer, Coach
- Current USDF membership (or n/m fees, number) for Rider and Owner. **Rider's USDF membership may be either Participating or Group, Owner's USDF membership may be Participating, Group or Business; if Rider/Owner's USDF # is a non member ID #, the USDF non-member fee must be paid.**
- USDF Horse ID.
- Current (1 Yr) negative coggins.
- For Adult Amateur classes - USEF membership card must declare Amateur, or include \$30 amateur nonmember declaration fee.
- Juniors and Young Riders must include birthdate.
- Freestyle entries - copy of a 60% + at the highest test of the MFS level or higher.

FOR GAIG / USDF QUALIFYING CLASSES ALSO INCLUDE:

- Check "Qualifying" and add \$10 per Qualifying class.
- Copies of USEF and USDF Horse Registrations (not HID #s).
- Rider must have current Participating USDF membership; Owner must have current Participating or Business USDF membership.
- Rider, Owner, Trainer and Coach must have current USEF membership.

ALL ENTRIES must have THREE signatures - Rider, Owner and Trainer. Legal Guardian must sign for riders under 18 yrs. Trainer blank must be signed by person over 18 who assumes responsibility for horse. (Parents who sign as trainer are exempt from membership requirements).

USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT



Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 nonmember registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.


Federation Entry Agreement

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of the competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable - casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4
